We are confident that with your help, we will shape the LA story anew – and build the LA2050 of our dreams.

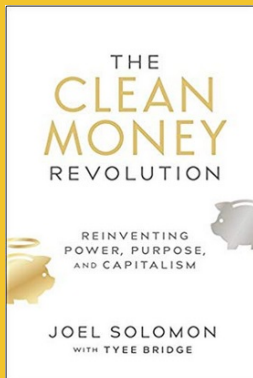
