 photographer and was the only researcher who was working with instruments,
 looking for quantifiable effects from being in the circles.
- Michael Tellinger, founder of the beautiful Ubunto Liberation Movement, houseguested with me on his swing through L.A. a few years ago when he was presenting material dealing with ancient ruins in South Africa.
